

OFFICIAL LANGUAGES

The Bowling Federation of Canada will ensure that service to the public of both official language communities and in communication with the public shall be provided in both official languages in accordance with the spirit and intent of Part IV of *Official Languages Act 1985, rev. May 1999*.

All announcements to the public by the Bowling Federation of Canada concerning activity, project or programme shall be made in both official languages.

In geographic areas, where warranted by linguistic population, the Bowling federation of Canada shall actively offer services to members of the public in both official languages.

The Bowling Federation of Canada shall make available in both official languages any documents for the general public relating to the activities, projects or programmes.

The Bowling Federation of Canada shall encourage members of both official language communities to participate in their activities, projects and programmes.

The Bowling Federation of Canada shall organize activities, projects or programmes, when appropriate, in such a manner as to meet the needs of the two linguistic communities.

The Bowling Federation of Canada shall encourage and assist its members in provision of activities, projects, programmes and services to the public, in both official languages.
